SUPPLY CHAIN code of practice

Supporting Share Fair is an important part of the Supply Chain Code of Practice which was launched in 2002 under the PILOT progressing partnership initiative. It comprises of a set of best practice guidelines designed to enhance UKCS supply chain efficiency by:

- Improving performance
- Eliminating unnecessary costs
- Enhancing competitiveness

At PILOT Share Fair 10, Oil & Gas UK launched a new tiered compliance system specific to the Supply Chain Code of Practice. This new scheme aims to provide a structured system for continuous progression towards fuller compliance as far as is practically possible and achievable within the boundaries of companies' corporate constraints. It is recognised that some organisations may never be able to fully comply with all aspects of the code, despite reasonable efforts and the new tiered system will allow those companies to comply with the Code on a level that they feel most comfortable with.

In order to obtain 'gold level status' companies must demonstrate a commitment to support the PILOT Share Fair every two years.
